Storage and Handling

No specific education is required for safe handling. Avoid damp conditions for storage.

Packaging

Packaged in an outer cardboard box.

Disposal/Repair

Any excess leftover product can be saved for another project or recycled in accordance with local authority requirements. Fibreglass Joint Tape which has joint compound on should be disposed of according to the requirements of the joint compound.

Health & Safety

No special precautions are necessary but the use of gloves are recommended during the handling and installation of this product.

Application / Installation

To use to complete tape and jointing finishes to tapered edge plasterboard: Use a minimum of 1mm of Knauf jointing compound (joint filler premium/joint cement premium or fill & finish) to bed the tape and fill to the shoulder of the taper of the plasterboard. Add a liberal coat of Knauf Joint Filler Premium over the top, fill the joint to the shoulder of the taper. Smooth and allow to set. Once set, apply Knauf Joint Cement Premium or Fill & Finish Light over the entire layer to approximately 50mm extra either side of the first coat and leave to dry. Repeat, and when fully dry, sand if needed. Jointing should be completed in accordance with BS 8000-8:2023.
